Ebola Virus Disease: Awareness and Precautions for Peace Operations Personnel



This course, developed in partnership with the World Health Organization (WHO), is intended to be a general introductory primer to Ebola awareness and prevention for peace operations personnel who are not working in a medical or public health capacity.

This course presents a compilation of WHO materials on general information about Ebola virus disease, how the virus is spread, the symptoms and diagnosis, infection prevention techniques, possible treatments and vaccination, mission protocol, and outbreak response coordination.

Learning Objectives:

Have an increased understanding of the 2014 EVD outbreak and those that have followed.

Learn how EVD spreads and who is most at risk of infection.

Recognize the clinical symptoms and diagnosis of EVD.

Be familiar with basic strategies and techniques to prevent infection and protect against spreading the virus to others.

Understand strategies to stay healthy before and during a peace operations mission.

Know how to handle stress in the context of an EVD outbreak.

Recognize the precautions and risks of travel and transport when going to an area where there is an Ebola outbreak.

Better understand when to seek medical care.

Learn how EVD is treated and about care for people recovered from EVD.

Know about the available Ebola vaccines.

Understand peace operation coordination during an EVD outbreak.

Learn about United Nations involvement during an EVD outbreak.
