Presenting: Leading Within Peace Operations

The dynamic leadership of United Nations peace operations is critical to success in an increasingly complex environment. This course provides knowledge and guidance on the strategic, operational, and tactical activities of mission leaders. It is designed for those in leadership positions in United Nations peace operations or those wishing to understand the issues associated with leading peace operations. Applicable to civilian, military, and police, this course is practitioner-oriented and supplemented with case studies.

The course provides an overview of the United Nations peace and security architecture and the linkages within the United Nations system that impact peace operations. Lessons address strategic planning by the Secretariat and on mission, the multidimensional convergence of stakeholders, and cross-cutting issues. The course also summarizes flexible mission support, green peacekeeping, and technology integration as a force multiplier. Seven lessons.
