Understand the ways in which contemporary armed conflict has differential impacts on society.

Understand the importance of addressing gender inequalities in post-conflict reconstruction processes.

Understand the gender dimensions of war and peacemaking in a number of conflicts occurring in Africa.

Understand the priorities and challenges of the various sub-regions and countries in Africa regarding the implementation of the WPS agenda.

Understand the role of women's organizations and other stakeholders in advancing the WPS agenda.
