It explores recent National Action Plans, evolving strategies for enhancing women's political participation, and best practices for gender mainstreaming.

Learning Objectives:

Understand the importance of promoting gender equality and the empowerment of women and girls.

Identify the UN system's main documents and decisions affirming equal rights as they relate to international peace and security.

Understand the conceptual and political framework that led to the passage of UNSCR 1325 (2000) and its importance for promoting a gender perspective in the areas of peace and security.

Understand the ways in which contemporary armed conflict has differential impacts on society.

Discuss the current state of armed conflict and peace and security in Latin America and the Caribbean.

Understand the gendered dimensions of peace and security in Latin America and the Caribbean.

Discuss issues relating to WPS in the LAC region within the conceptual framework of UNSCR 1325 (2000) and subsequent resolutions.

Understand the roles of the various regional and subregional institutions and mechanisms working on the WPS agenda in Latin America and the Caribbean.
